### ***A Visit to General Crook Museum with Afternoon Tea***

**Date: Sunday, July 12, 2020**

**Time: 1:30 – 4:00 PM**

The General Crook House is the award-winning, authentically restored home of General George Crook at Fort Omaha. The Italianate house built in 1879 and on the National Register of Historic Places, shows how a Commanding Officer lived on the Frontier in the 1880s. An elegant afternoon tea will be served in the Crook House dining room with a proper silver tea service and fresh flowers. Included is a guided tour of the beautifully appointed rooms and the heirloom garden with more than 110 varieties of flowers and plants.

***Cuisines: Omaha Classics – A Private Cooking Class***

Omaha is home to some classic “American” foods, and the Metropolitan Community College Culinary Arts School has developed an Open Kitchen Workshop especially for you to learn more about these local classics. In the 3-hour session with instructors from the Culinary School, discover what makes Rye bread sandwiches, cheese French fries, and Butterbrickle ice cream the Omaha favorites they’ve become. Take part in a culinary school environment to learn the techniques needed for you to make these specialties at home. Each participant will get to enjoy eating these three Omaha classics at the end of the lesson.
